Union Financial Officers

A two-day intensive course for union officers responsible for private and Iowa public sector union financial recordkeeping. Presented by the Labor Center, in cooperation with the Iowa Federation of Labor, AFL-CIO, and featuring guest instructors with expertise in the law and practice of union finances. Topics will include:

- Writing and recording union income and expenditures
- IRS 990 form and requirements
- Rules for reporting political activities
- Understanding LM-2s, LM-3s, LM-4s, and PERB forms
- LM-30: individual reporting
- Internal audits: what to do and how to do it
- Dept. of Labor and IRS audits: what to expect and how to prepare
